Object Pronouns = Objective Pronouns = ضمیرهای مفعولی

Subject Pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they

Object Pronouns: me, you, him, her, it, us, them

Point:

Whenever you want to use a pronoun instead of the object of the sentence, you should use an object pronoun, not a subject pronoun.

instead of = به جای

Examples:

Don't Say: I like **he**.

Say: I like **him**.

Don't Say: He can see **they**.

Say: He can see **them**.

Point:

If you want to use a pronoun after a preposition, you must use an object pronoun, not a subject pronoun.

preposition = حرف اضافه

Prepositions: in, at, of, with, on, under, above, next to, beside, by, ...

Don't Say: Robert is going to the park **with we**.

Say: Robert is going to the park **with us**.

Don't Say: He is tired **of she**.

Say: He is tired **of her**.

Don't Say: Monica is sitting **next to they**.

Say: Monica is sitting **next to them**.
