Stress

There are two types of stress:

- Word Stress
- Sentence Stress

Word Stress = The Stress on a Syllable in a Word

Example:

Japan => The word has two syllable: “Ja” + “pan”. The stress is on “pan”.

Pencil => The word has two syllable: “Pen” + “cil”. The stress is on "Pen".

Sentence Stress = The Stress on the Important Words of a Sentence

Example:

They **always** play **volleyball** on the **weekend**.

Point:

There is usually **stress on an adverb of frequency** in the sentence. In other words, adverbs of frequency are stressed.

Adverbs of Frequency: never, seldom, rarely, usually, often, generally, always
