deliver (v.) = give things to people

delivery (n.) = delivering things to people; something that a person should deliver

delivery person = a person whose job is giving things to people

➤ *A delivery person delivers things to people.*

per = in

so = therefore

wage = دستمزد

1 mile = 1.6 kilometers

80 miles = 128 kilometers

🚗 my car = ماشینم

🚗 my own car = ماشین خودم

tip = انعام
