daily = done everyday

routine = What you do every day

daily routines = things that we usually do every day

tooth (singular) => teeth (plural)



toothbrush (noun) = a tool that we use to brush our teeth

brush one's teeth (verb) = clean and wash our with a toothbrush

- *How often do you brush your teeth?*
- *I brush my teeth twice a day.*



comb (noun) = a tool that we use to comb our hair

comb (verb) = tidy up our hair with a comb

- *Sally combs her hair four times a day.*

prayers (n.) = talking to God and asking him to help us

say one's prayers = talk to God as a religious activity

- *Muslims say their prayers five times a day.*
- *Please remember me in your prayers!*

set = adjust

stay up late = not sleep and stay awake

sleep late = sleep for a long time for example until noon

nap = short sleep, siesta

➤ *On hot summer days, a lot of people take a nap in the afternoon.*

take a shower = wash your body under a shower

take a bath = wash your body in a bathtub
