like = similar to

What + am/is/are + Subject + like?

What	am	I	like?
	is	he she it	
	are	you we they	

Example:

What is your friend **like**? = What kind of person is your friend?

He is fat and short. ➔ **appearance**

He is very generous. ➔ **character = personality**

What are your parents **like**? = What kind of persons are your parents?

They are very good-looking. ➔ **appearance**

They are very kind. ➔ **character = personality**

What am I like? = What kind of person am I?

You are tall and thin. ➔ **appearance**

You're very strict. ➔ **character = personality**

like = enjoy

What + do/does + Subject + like?

What	do	I you we they	like?
	does	he she it	

Example:

What **does** your friend **like**?

He likes PS5 games.

What **do** your parents **like**?

They like modern cars.

What **do** I **like**?

You like ice cream.

Spelling Note

Verb Ending in a Consonant & "y" + (e)s

study + es => studies

carry + es => carries

Verb Ending in a Vowel & "y" + (e)s

vowel = a, e, i, o, u

play + s => plays

stay + s => stays

enjoy + s => enjoys
