casual = informal ≠ formal

- *Tom prefers casual clothes. He usually wears a T-shirt and jeans.*
- *Michael prefers formal clothes. He usually wears a suit.*

comfortable /'kʌm.fə.tə.bəl/ ≠ uncomfortable

- *She is sleeping in a very comfortable bed.*

fashion (n.) = a style that is popular at a particular time, especially in clothes, hair, make-up, etc.

- *This year, yellow is in fashion.*
- *Nowadays thick eyebrows are in fashion for women and thin eyebrows are out of fashion.*
- *Long hair is back in fashion for men.*

fashionable (adj.) = according to the latest fashion

- *Sally usually wears fashionable clothes.*



helmet = a hat which protects your head



high heels = high-heeled shoes for women

smart = good-looking, beautiful

- *You look smart today.*

smart = clever, intelligent

- *Robert is a smart boy.*



sneakers (American) = trainers (British)

stylish = beautiful, good-looking

➤ *Mary always buys stylish clothes.*
