**few/a few + Plural Countable Noun**

plural = جمع ≠ singular = مفرد

countable = قابل شمارش پذیر، قابل شمارش ≠ uncountable

noun = اسم

**few = not enough; almost no      a few = enough, but not many**

almost no = تقریباً هیچ

Examples:

- There are **few** taxis on the street at this time. You **can't** go back home easily.
- There are **a few** taxis on the street at this time. You **can** go back home easily.
- We have **few** tomatoes. We **can't** make an omelet.
- We have **a few** tomatoes. We **can** make an omelet.

**little/a little + Uncountable Noun**

**little = not enough; almost no = ناچیز      a little = enough, but not much**

Examples:

- Tom has **little** money. He **can't** buy an ice cream.
- Mary has **a little** money. She **can** buy an ice cream.
- We have **little** rice. I **can't** cook lunch.
- We have **a little** rice. I **can** cook lunch.

**Sample Question:**

There is ..... water in the pool. We can't swim in it.

The Right Answer: c

We have ..... computers at school. The students can work on their projects here.

- a) few      b) a few      c) little      d) a little
