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## Liaison = The Linking of the Sounds

Word Ending in a Consonant + Word Starting with a Vowel

**Vowels** => a, e, o, i, u

**Point:**

When a word ends in a consonant and the next word starts with a vowel, liaison happens.

Examples:

The car **i** in the garage **e** is a Toyota.

car == **Liaison** == in  
garage == **Liaison** == is

Hal == **Liaison** == enjoys

l => consonant

e => vowel

2. Corn grows well **i**n Mexico.

well == **Liaison** == in

l => consonant

i => vowel

3. A meat **a**nd cheese sandwich **is** my favorite dish.

meat == **Liaison** == and

t => consonant

a => vowel

sandwich == **Liaison** == is

ch => consonant

i => vowel

4. My friend **is** eating a hamburger.

friend == **Liaison** == is

d => consonant

i => vowel
