➤ **General Tendency = What you usually like to do**

**The Simple Present Form of the Verbs “like”, “love”, & “prefer”**

*I like ice cream a lot.*

*Michael loves coffee.*

*Sally prefers pizza to spaghetti.*

*Robert doesn't like fish.*

➤ **What you want right now**

**would + like**

*I'd like some vanilla ice cream.* = I want some vanilla ice cream now.

**would + prefer**

*Richard would prefer a coke.* = He wants to drink a coke now.

**would + love**

*They would love some tea.* = They want to drink some tea now.
