adventure (n.) = an exciting event or story

adventurous (adj.) = looking for adventure

- *Robert is an adventurous man. He always looks for adventure. He doesn't like a boring lifestyle.*

anxious = stressed (out), worried

- *Students usually feel anxious on the day of an important exam.*

appear ≠ disappear

disappear = vanish

- *The sun appeared from behind the clouds.*
- *After the police officers arrived, the gangsters disappeared from the street.*

awake ≠ asleep

awake = not sleeping

asleep = sleeping

creative (adj.) = showing or having creativity

- *Sally is a very creative girl. She always finds creative solutions to difficult problems.*

fussy = choosy

- *Mary is a fussy woman. It is very difficult for her to make a decision about what she wants to buy.*

- **green** => When a fruit is green, it isn't usually delicious and not good to eat.

- **ripe** => The best time to eat a fruit is the time when it is ripe.

- **overripe** => When a fruit becomes overripe, it is too soft and not delicious.

tight ≠ loose

tight = too fixed; hard to move or open

- *I don't like tight jeans.*
- *Jack's shoes were too tight for his feet.*
