**The Different Meanings of "Bill":**

- **bill** = a piece of paper which shows how much money you have to pay
- **bill** (American) = note (British) = paper money
- **Bill** = a male name



**a whistle**

**whistle** (noun) = a tool that we use to produce a shrill, high-pitched sound, especially for giving a signal

**whistle** (verb) = make a shrill, high-pitched sound to give a signal especially by forcing breath through a small hole between one's lips or teeth

**blow** = push out air or breath

**blow a whistle** = make a signaling sound with a whistle

- *The referee blew his whistle and the game started.*  
referee = a person who judges a game

**bother** = annoy, disturb

- **burst** = explode
- **burst into tears** = start to weep
- **burst into laughter** = start to laugh
- **burst into song** = start to sing

**complain** = say that you are unhappy with somebody or something

**cash** = the money that you can pay

**make an offer** = make a suggestion

**schedule** = timetable

- ✚ **slip** (v.) = lose one's balance
  - *Be careful not to slip on the ice!*

✚ slip (n.) = an act of slipping

✚ slippery (adj.) = difficult to hold firmly or stand on because it is smooth, wet, or slimy

- *The road is very slippery. Please drive carefully!*
