nutrition (noun) = the process of taking in and using food, or the scientific study of this

nutritional (adjective) = related to nutrition

Chemical sweeteners have no nutritional value.

nutritious (adjective) = healthy, health-giving

Raw spinach is especially nutritious.

nutritionist (n.) = an expert in nutrition
