cling → clung, clung

miracle = wonder

indicate = point out, state

injure (verb) = hurt

➤ *The earthquake injured 54 people.*

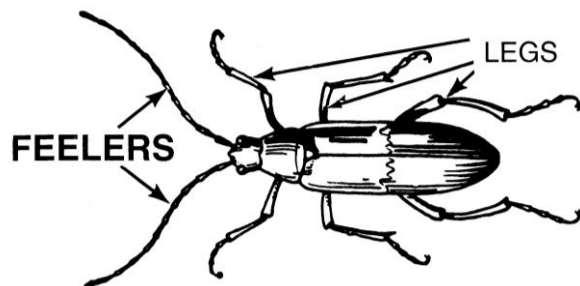
be injured (verb) = be hurt

➤ *54 people were injured by the earthquake.*

➤ *Tom was injured in the accident.*

injury (noun) = being injured

➤ *His injury was not very serious.*

judge (noun) = a public officer appointed to decide cases in a law court

➤ *A judge works at a court of law.*

judge (verb) = decide (a case) in a law court; decide the results of (a competition)

➤ *Who is going to judge the next game?*

judgment (noun) = a decision of a law court or judge; an opinion or a conclusion

➤ *His judgment was very logical.*

miracle (noun) = wonder; an extraordinary event

miraculous (adjective) /mə'ɹæk.jə.ləs/ = looking like a miracle

stand out (verb) = be excellent

➤ *His paintings stand out among many other paintings by great masters of art.*

outstanding (adjective) = excellent

➤ *His paintings are outstanding.*

require (v.) = need

requirement (n.) = need, necessity

sight = vision; the ability to see
