adjust = customize

- *This button is for adjusting the volume.*
- *Adjust your language to the age of your audience.*

adopt = to start using something

- *All three teams adopted different approaches to the problem.*

architect = a person who designs buildings

architecture = the art of designing buildings

- ❖ We pronounce ch as /k/ in "architect" and "architecture".

associate = link, relate

- *I always associate the smell of baking with my childhood.*
- *Most people immediately associate addictions with drugs, alcohol and cigarettes.*

climate vs. weather

The climate is the weather conditions of a particular area over a long period of time and it doesn't change much. But the weather is for a short period of time and changes a lot.

- Climate ⇒ *Tehran's climate is warm and dry.*
- Weather ⇒ *Tehran's weather today was rainy.*

dawn ≠ dusk

dawn = daybreak, sunrise

- *In Ramadan, Muslims fast from dawn to dusk.*
- *Muslims say their dawn prayers early in the morning before the sunrise.*

general = rough, inexact, overall

- *They gave a general description of the man.*
