baggage = luggage, suitcases

Point:

The words "baggage" and "luggage" are uncountable. We can't add the plural "s" to them and we have to use a singular verb after them.

Example:

✗ My **baggages** are heavy.

✓ My **baggage** is heavy.

blame = scold, reprimand, hold responsible

- *Why is he blaming others for his problems?*
- *You can't really blame them for not telling you.*
- *Police are blaming the accident on dangerous driving.*

equipment = tools

Point:

"Equipment" is uncountable.

✗ We need **two equipments**.

✓ We need **two pieces of equipment**.

✓ We need **some equipment**.

loss ≠ gain

American	British
parking lot	car park
restroom	toilet

prohibit = forbid, ban

- *The law in Iran prohibits the sale of alcoholic drinks.*

publicity = advertising
