advance = progress

affect (verb) have an impact on

➤ *The rate of inflation affects our lifestyle.*

effect (noun) = impact

➤ *The effect of inflation on our lifestyle is considerable.*

convince = persuade

disadvantage ≠ advantage

doubt (noun) = uncertainty

➤ *There is no doubt about it.*

doubt (verb) = have doubts

➤ *The police officer doubted (that) his plan might work.*

drug = medicine, medication

invent (v.) = make something new for the first time

➤ *Thomas Edison invented the light-bulb.*

invention (n.) = something that has been invented; the act of inventing something

➤ *Thomas Edison is famous for his important inventions.*

inventor (n.) = a person who has invented something

➤ *Thomas Edison is the most famous inventor the world has ever seen.*

permanent ≠ temporary

permanent = lasting for ever

temporary = lasting for a short time

replace A with B = substitute B for A

➤ *The mechanic replaced the broken radiator with a new one.*

➤ *The mechanic substituted a new radiator for the old one.*

stand = tolerate, put up with, bear

can't stand = hate

sick and tired of sb/sth = fed up with sb/sth
