death (n.) = being dead

deadly (adj.) = causing death

exception = oddity = an abnormal case

exhausted = very tired; run-down; drained

household (adj.) = domestic = related to someone's house.

➤ *household appliances*

household (n.) = family

➤ *Peace be upon prophet Mohammad and his holy household.*

➤ *The whole household was asleep.*

➤ *By the 1960s, most households had a TV.*

mess = untidiness; dirt

messy = untidy; dirty

relevant = pertinent ≠ irrelevant; impertinent

➤ *Education should be relevant to the child's needs.*

➤ *The point is highly relevant to this discussion.*

survey = study; research
